The Need to Connect (NTC) project includes partners from Iceland, Bulgaria, Italy, Lithuania, the Netherlands, Slovenia and Spain.

The Need to Connect project aims to fight loneliness, to empower and connect young mothers, between 18 and 30 years old, through arts education and to build a sustainable national community platform and network in all partner countries.

Loneliness in the European Union

According to the European Commission's JRC Science for Policy report from 2021, single households have been increasing across the EU since 2010 and negative feelings ("downhearted", "tense", "lonely") among the European populations have risen due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Young mothers are one of the groups especially at risk of experiencing loneliness: They are often isolated from their peers, stay at home and have limited or no social life.

The Need to Connect project aims to tackle this loneliness and support them in building a closer connection to others and their surroundings through a national network and a community platform.





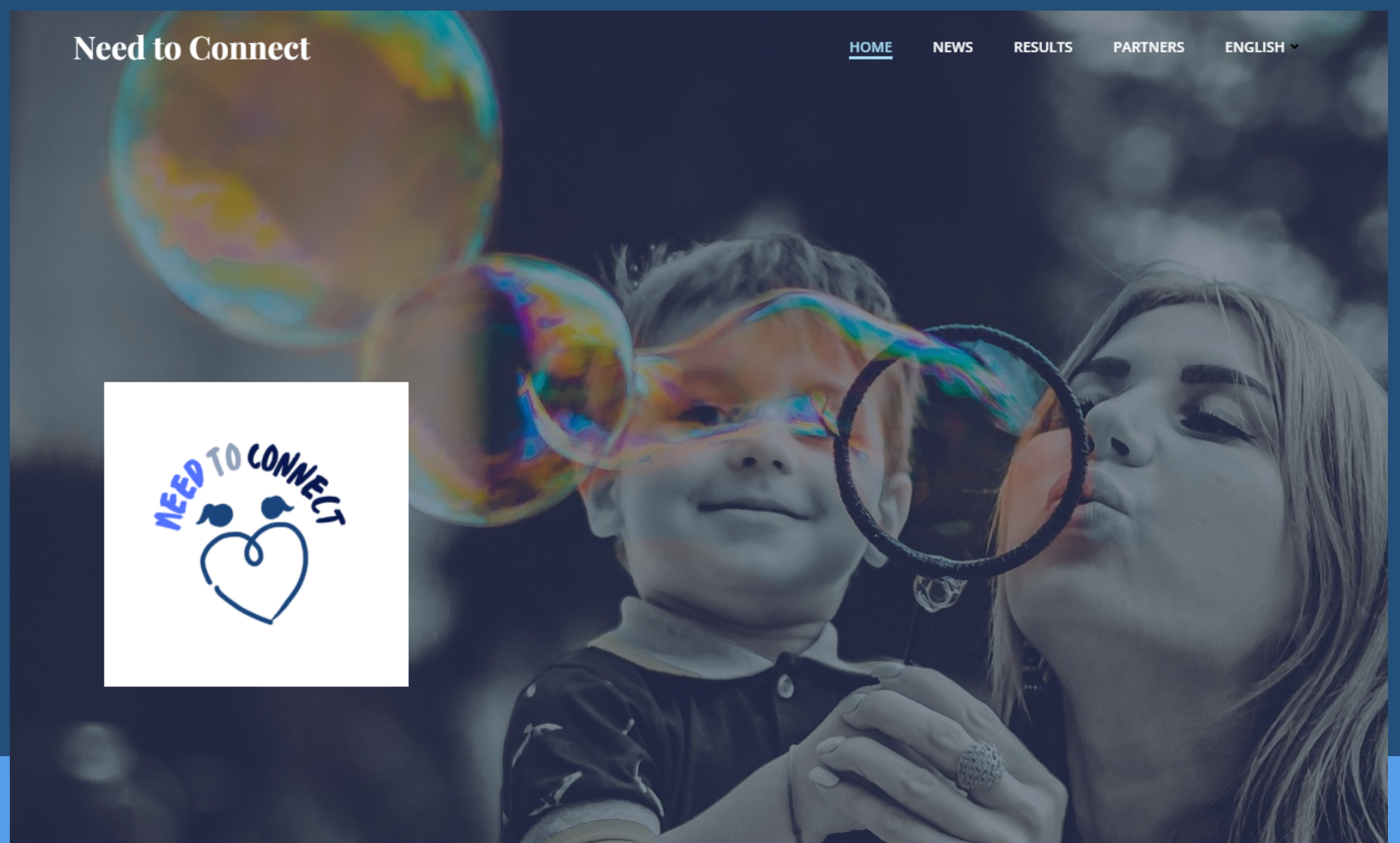
